1. Over-population of the deer in Saddle River:
  - a. Issues of Lyme Disease growing.
  - b. Issues of too many car accidents caused by deer.  
\*\*\**(Wants Mayor & Council to approve killing of deer in Saddle River)*\*\*\*  
*Motion from Dr. Parker to ask Mayor & Council to "Look into ways of reducing the Deer Population," seconded by Dr. Rossaski, all in favor.*
2. Garbage all over town, too much litter all around:
  - a. Overfilled dumpsters behind the stores in Saddle River
    1. Dumpsters get filled, and overflow goes in river.  
\*\*\**(Wants all dumpsters closed, and picked up more often)*\*\*\*  
*Recommendation from Dr. Carpenter to ask Mayor & Council to "Enforce garbage dumpsters closed and dumped on a regular basis (not overflowing) and have littering fines enforced," seconded by George Tashji, all in favor.*
  - b. Also, the landscapers in town throw their lunch all around and leave bottles with urine filled in them, a serious health issue.  
*Linda Canavan, will notify all the landscapers registered in Saddle River about the garbage concerns made by landscapers and the fines involved.*
