Old Business:

Dr. Carpenter asked about the Marker House. Dr. Kurpis said they are still looking at options (suggestions) for the Marker House and the Bishop House. Dr. Kurpis stated that right before the most recent snow storm they had an OEM meeting and were discussing the possibility of using the Bishop House as a warming station. At that meeting they found that Saddle River would be okay for that storm but there is still much to consider and take care of in the OEM Department. Saddle River could use more volunteers (to train) and join the CERT Program to help with these emergency situations. George Tashji is a CERT member and spoke of some of his training.

Dr. Kurpis added that the Saddle River Police Department has just finished an Assessment Accreditation. Only 20% of the Police Departments in the State of New Jersey have this high level. We are very fortunate to have such a dedicated and professional Police Department. They just got the preliminary approval for this new level and this very outstanding.

This year our Police Department is planning to have a class for Licensed Gun Owners to know fundamental things on how to use a gun (brush up) and mainly safety awareness, possibly more geared toward women.

Dr. Kurpis talked on how the Fire Department has really turned around, going from No Saddle River Residents to now a dozen Saddle River Residents on our Fire Department, and mainly thanks to Jake Kossowsky the New Fire Chief, and Brian Yates the Assistant to the Fire Chief. They have really turned our bad situation completely around and they need to be commended for such a good job. They have answered every single fire call since they are on and at least eleven members show up for each fire. Right now we have six more people getting trained!

Dr. Kurpis mentioned the Museum floors have been sanded, and everything will be put back. The Museum should be up and running by the spring time, we are so looking forward to the opening.

Dr. Kurpis added some History of Saddle River. Did you know that Saddle River is the fourth in the State to have many significant historical structures in it? Saddle River has such a history that we should preserve it, even our beautiful trees. There is no protection for Historical Houses or Historical trees, as a community we have to take care of our History. He asked that we all read his son's document on the Saddle River Website on our History, it is very informative.
