Russell Huntington, Borough Attorney approved the attached Ordinance. Angela read the attached Ordinance to Amend Ordinance Chapter No. 29-12 regarding Health Care Fees (to match North West Bergen Regional Health Commission's Fees). This is the first reading of this Ordinance and was then motioned by Dr. John Azzariti, Jr., seconded by George Tashji, and approved by all. This Ordinance will now be sent to the Mayor and Council either for approval or for them to pass it at Mayor and Council, with the Board of Health's approval. Motion to approve by George Tashji, seconded Stafford Patentas and all in favor.

New Business: At the end of April the NJ DEP said they are going to publicly identify where lead service lines are. Lead is seldom ever introduced to water at the source usually the heavy metal reaches into the water as it winds through the distribution system most commonly the pipes in a home. So NJ DEP told the EPA that Water Suppliers must put the lead service lines on the website so people can see how their homes are getting water, this website should be available soon.

Open to Public: Mayor Kurpis stated about the air quality in the Borough Hall is being checked. Also, Mayor Kurpis listed how the space is being organized in the Borough Hall, and in the near future the Borough of Saddle River will be going paperless. Mayor Kurpis discussed about educating residents to recycle. The Board then spoke about a welcome package to inform new residents about the town. Then Mayor Kurpis said we could put a link on the website for newcomers.
