APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mr. Ceccon moved for the approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of October 8, 2014 as written; Seconded by Mrs. Nazzaro, Voice Vote: AYES Unanimous.

OUTDOOR GYM PRESENTATION:

David Siegel, President prepared two proposals for the Borough and explained how the hydraulic core elements outdoor gym equipment is used in different areas and how it would be beneficial to Saddle River. Following a brief discussion, Board members indicated that they would like to see the equipment before making any decisions. Mr. Siegel invited the Board to Teaneck Park in Teaneck, NJ where the equipment will be installed this spring.

FIELD HOUSE BATHROOMS:

Mrs. Boyajian reported that the field house bathrooms should be started and completed by the spring.

EDUCATION FOUNDATION REQUEST
FOR TWO PARKING SPOTS:

The Saddle River Education Foundation has requested the Parks & Recreation Commission to consider granting the Foundation two dedicated front row parking spots in Rindlaub Park (near the athletic fields) to be included as part of their auction fund raiser.

Mrs. Nazzaro moved to deny the request because public parking is unlike school parking and very difficult to enforce. Seconded by Mr. Barry; Roll Call Vote: AYES Unanimous.
