Resolution Regarding the Coyote Problem in Saddle River

WHEREAS, in 2015 a resident of Saddle River was attacked by a rabid coyote, and

WHEREAS, there are multiple concentrations of coyotes in Saddle River that are known to Saddle River's Animal Control Officer, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Saddle River, County of Bergen that the presence of coyotes in Saddle River poses a danger to residents, visitors and pets;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Administrator and the Animal Control Officer are each authorized to take any and all active measures allowed under prevailing law to reduce the coyote population within the Borough of Saddle River;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Administrator is directed to work with the Animal Control Officer and the Wildlife Management Committee to create a plan to reduce Saddle River's coyote population and is directed to report on his progress at the June regular meeting of Mayor and Council.
